WILLIAM FREEMAN MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP

William Freeman was an educator and Principal in the Reed-Custer School District for 33 years. For 22 years as principal of the high school, with his support, encouragement and contributions, the music department has grown to be a respected and important aspect of Reed-Custer High School. In honor of Mr. Freeman's legacy and dedication to the music department, the RCHS Music Boosters are awarding a \$500.00 scholarship to a graduating senior.

Scholarship Guidelines

- 1. The applicant must be a senior who has been in band and or chorus for all four years of high school.
- 2. The applicant must be accepted for enrollment at an accredited college, university, community college or technical school.
- 3. The applicant must submit a written, typed essay on the following topics: How are you going to use what you have learned from the music department in your everyday, adult life (please be specific in the examples) and explain how you have gone above and beyond the program requirements to improve the RCHS Music Department.
- 4. The applicant must complete the entire application to be considered for the scholarship. Late entries will not be accepted. In addition to the essay, the applicant must fill in a list of all music activities, groups, and volunteer work within their four years in the RCHS Music Department.
- 5. The applicant must attach two recommendation letters from teachers or sponsors (boy/girl scout leader, pastor, coaches, etc.) as a testimony to their leadership, character and commitment.
- 6. Applications will be turned in to the music department. The completed application must be received by 3:00 pm on Thursday, May 2nd.
- 7. The RCHS Music Boosters will review the applications, vote, and reward the scholarship to the student who demonstrates: Leadership, character, commitment and has gone beyond the requirements of the program. (The parents vote on the winner, directors do not vote.)
